Pasadena's strengths as a tech and design hub can be found in our stats:

- Pasadena has best-in-class institutions like Caltech, JPI and Art Center.
- Pasadena receives more federal R & D funding than any other U.S. innovation hub... almost \$2B annually.
- Nearly 1 in 6 jobs in Pasadena are in creative or professional fields-besting San Jose, Seattle, Austin and Portland. 17% of Pasadena's workforce is in a technical or scientific field.
- Pasadena's educational institutions have produced one of the highest concentrations of Nobel Laureates in the world-some 31 to date.
- Pasadena is home to 3 of the world's top 15 engineering and design firms.
- Bill Gross started Idealab in 1996 to create and operate pioneering technology companies. Since then, Idealab has created more than 150 companies. including CitySearch, eToys, Overture Services, Picasa, **Evolution Robotics.** UberMedia and New Matter.
